My work has always centered on improving the health of queer people — both one patient at a time and at a population level. That throughline runs from advocacy in medical school, through outreach re-engaging people living with HIV, to finishing residency in Public Health & Preventive Medicine while practicing at an FQHC where most patients are on PrEP or HIV treatment. I believe PrEP is our clearest path to ending new HIV transmissions.
